1. Species: Blue Marlin (BM), White Marlin (WM), Sailfish (SF)
2. Hook Type: Circle (C) or J-Hook (J), also note size (C 7/0)
3. Hook Location: Jaw (J), Bill (B), Mouth Cavity (M), Gills (G), Deep/Gut (D), Fowl (F), Unknown (U)
4. Rig Type: Natural Dead (ND), Natural Live (NL), Combo-Natural/Artificial (C), Lure (L)
5. Bait Type: Ballyhoo (B), Spanish Mackerel (SM), Squid (S), Mullet (M), other (O). ***If rig is a lure, note the number of hooks in the Bait Type***
6. Leader: Size of mono (Leader will be considered mono unless wire is noted)
7. Main Line: size of backing

Release Points: Cash prizes will be awarded to the boats that score the greatest number of points first. No release points will be awarded if the gaff breaks the outside vertical plane of the boat. In the event of a tie in total release points, the tie breakers shall be the largest single gamefish (dolphin, yellowfin tuna, or wahoo) by weight. If no gamefish are caught the winner will be determined by the first boat to achieve the winning total. ***In order to qualify as a release, the billfish must remain in the water (Federal Law).***

Release Points will only be given for blue marlin, white marlin, and sailfish. When the mate touches the leader or the leader touches the rod tip before the fish is released.

BLUE MARLIN : 400 Release Points

WHITE MARLIN/SAILFISH : 150 Release Points
